

***Shepherd's House***  
**Pre-admission Requirements**

Applicants for admission to the Shepherd's House program must meet the following minimum requirements in order to be considered for admission.

1. Male, 18 years of age or older, willing to complete a 12-18 month treatment program on site.
2. Be enrolled or have recently completed a 28-30 day residential treatment program or a state certified alcohol/drug treatment program while incarcerated
3. Once individual has entered a 28-30 day residential program, or if incarcerated, a certified treatment program, they may contact Shepherd's House by phone or letter to complete an intake questionnaire. If the individual meets admission requirements he will then be placed on the waiting list and must contact Shepherd's House staff weekly (if not incarcerated) or bi-weekly by letter (if incarcerated) in order to remain on the waiting list.
4. Have not been adjudicated guilty for: arson, murder, rape, other sexual offenses, or aggravated assault charges.
5. Must be able to climb stairs and perform physical labor. If unable to be employed full-time, must be able to perform a minimum of 30 hours of volunteer service.
6. Agree to a criminal history background check
7. During this program clients must meet weekly with therapists, and attend group counseling session throughout the week. Clients must attend a specific number of AA/NA.
8. Deposit of \$150 due at time of admission. If applicant is unable to do so, he will have to discuss payment arrangements with staff prior to admission.
9. Residents are required to pay treatment fees of \$95 a week.
